River Bend Watercross 2007

We will again be at Petersen Park in McHenry IL. Dates for the event will be Sept. 29th & 30th, 2007. Here is some information about lodging. Unfortunately since Peterson Park is a city park there will be no camping, fires, etc. There is also a city ordinance against dogs within the fenced in area of the watercross. There are several motels reasonably close by and available to us. There is camping available also.

These are the options:

1. The Hampton Inn on the south side of McHenry on Rt 31 (about 4-5 miles from the event). We have 30 rooms reserved, there may be more available. Reservations can be made by phone (815) 578-1900 and ask for group code Watercross 2007 or 1-800-Hampton and ask for Watercross 2007 or go to www.hamptoninn.com under special accounts enter the Group/Convention code: WAT Room rate is \$84. They have a room that can be used as a hospitality room. To get the room rate reservations need to be made by Sep 3rd.
2. Next best is the Super 8 which is about ½ mile north of the Hampton on Rt 31. No rooms have been reserved. Reservations can be made by phone (815) 344-9200 or 1800-800-8000 on line at www.super8.com.
3. The 3rd choice is the Save Inn in Richmond, IL it is about 6 miles north of the event. Rates are about \$84 per night. We have no rooms reserved. Reservations can be made at (815) 678-4711 or at www.SaveInn.com.
4. Camping is available at Fish Lake Beach Resort. This is about 7-8 miles east of the event on RT 120 and slightly north on RT 12 in Volo, IL. Overnight camping is available for \$33 to \$35. Reservations can be made by phone (847)-546-2228

We are making arrangements for registration for Friday night at the same location as last year in McCullom Lake and the Sunday evening banquet will be held there also. We regret that due to the location pit bikes & 4 wheelers will not be allowed at the event except for use by race officials.
